***Debby Krim: The Colors of White***  
***June 24 – July 23, 2010***

Opening June 24 and on view until July 23<sup>rd</sup>, the Copley Society of art's newest exhibition in the Upper Gallery, *The Colors of White*, features the work of photographer Debby Krim. An opening reception will be held on Thursday, June 24<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 to 7:30pm at the ColSo gallery at 158 Newbury Street in Boston. All members are admitted free of charge, while non-members are asked to contribute \$10 to support gallery programming.

Debby Krim's evocative photography focuses on the shapes, textures, patterns, and beautifully simple variations within the color white. The magnification of her floral subjects allows for a visual exploration of a monochromatic theme. The exhibition at the Copley Society features Krim's success at capturing and experiencing a new medium through her camera lens. The effect is exhilarating and ethereal, yet tranquil.

Fine art has been a passion for Krim since high school when she purchased her first SLR camera. Since then, she has specialized in capturing the wonders and details in nature. She has studied at the Rhode Island School of Design, Brandeis University, and Boston University's School of Fine Arts. Her work is included in the collections of Lord & Taylor, Boston Children's Hospital, the Courtyard Marriott, and numerous private collection. Her work was also featured in the opening scene of Disney's 2008 Sandra Bullock movie, "The Proposal."

The Copley Society of art (ColSo), America's oldest non-profit organization, is committed to the advancement, enjoyment, and promotion of its member artists and the visual arts. The organization, founded in 1879, comprises juried artists who are selected by a credentialed art committee. ColSo provides artists with a gallery for exhibiting and selling their work and a platform for engaging and educating the community.
