The Copley Society of art opens the New Year with the *New Members' Show: 2010*, an annual showcase of the professional artist members accepted into the Society in the previous year. A public reception with the artists will be held at the ColSo galleries, located at 158 Newbury Street in Boston, on Thursday, January 14th from 5:30 – 7:30pm. All members will be admitted free of charge, while non-members are asked to contribute \$10 to support gallery programming.

The membership process reflects the Society's commitment to advancing the careers of emerging artists. Applications of prospective artist members are considered by the Membership Committee of the Copley Society, which meets three times annually. The applications are assessed based on the strength of a body of work and artists are granted membership if their art is found to be truly outstanding.

This year's *New Members' Show* includes a range of mediums, styles, and techniques, including painting, photography, and encaustic. The new artist members hail from diverse backgrounds: from young, emerging artists to more established artists with strong regional reputations. In addition to many local New England artists, a number of our new members have international backgrounds.
