***Summer Members' Show: "Shimmer"***  
**June 26 – August 20, 2009**

The Copley Society of art will host its second juried members' show of the year, an exhibition with a summer theme featuring beautiful pieces of art in varied mediums. The exhibition opens with a members' reception on Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 to 7:30 at the ColSo gallery, 158 Newbury Street, and continues through August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Members of the Copley Society will be admitted to the reception free of charge, while non-members will be asked to pay \$10 to benefit gallery programming.

This year's *Summer Members' Show* includes a range of mediums, styles, and techniques including painting and photography. Our members hail from diverse backgrounds: from young, emerging artists to more established artists with strong regional reputations. This year's jurors were Sallie Hirshberg, founder and CEO of Galerie d'Orsay, and Paul Tucker, The Paul Hayes Tucker Distinguished Professor of Art at the University of Massachusetts, Boston and guest curator of more than half a dozen major exhibitions, including *The Impressionists at Argenteuil* (National Gallery, Washington and the Wadsworth Athenaeum, 2000) and *Monet in the 20th Century* (Museum of Fine Arts, Boston and the Royal Academy of Arts London, 1998-99).

The Copley Society of art (ColSo), America's oldest non-profit organization, is committed to the advancement, enjoyment, and promotion of its member artists and the visual arts. The organization, founded in 1879, is comprised of juried artists who are selected by a credentialed art committee. ColSo provides artists with a gallery for exhibiting and selling their work and a platform for engaging and educating the community.

The Copley Society of art is located at 158 Newbury Street in Boston. The gallery is open Tuesday-Saturday, 11-6, Sunday 12-5 and closed Mondays.
