Summer Members' Show: "Wanderlust"
July 29 – August 26, 2010

The Copley Society of art will host its second juried members' show of the year, "Wanderlust" featuring exceptional artwork from Copley artist members. The exhibition opens with a members' reception on Thursday, July 29th from 5:30 to 7:30 at the ColSo gallery, 158 Newbury Street. The exhibition continues through August 26th, 2010.

This year's *Summer Members' Show* includes a range of media, styles, and techniques including painting, photography, and mixed media. Our members who submitted works for this exhibition were reviewed by two jurors: Hunter O'Hanian, Vice President of Institutional Advancement and Executive Director of the Foundation for Massachusetts College of Art and Design, and Peter Trippi, Editor of *Fine Art Connoisseur* and biographer of the painter J.W. Waterhouse.

Four awards have been granted: 1st Jurors' Choice to Martha Monroe for her ethereal acrylic piece, "Clouds I"; 2nd Jurors' Choice to Laurene Krasny Brown for her gouche string and cut paper work, "Papel Picado 130"; 3rd Jurors' Choice to Mark Chester's gritty silver print photograph, "Bus Depot"; and an Honorable Mention to Jennifer Day for her oil on panel painting, "Congestus I."

The Copley Society of art (ColSo), America's oldest non-profit organization, is committed to the advancement, enjoyment, and promotion of its member artists and the visual arts. The organization, founded in 1879, is comprised of juried artists who are selected by a credentialed art committee. ColSo provides artists with a gallery for exhibiting and selling their work and a platform for engaging and educating the community.

The Copley Society of art is located at 158 Newbury Street in Boston. The gallery is open Tuesday-Saturday, 11-6, Sunday 12-5 and closed Mondays. The opening reception is free for members while non-members will be asked to pay \$10 to benefit gallery programming.
